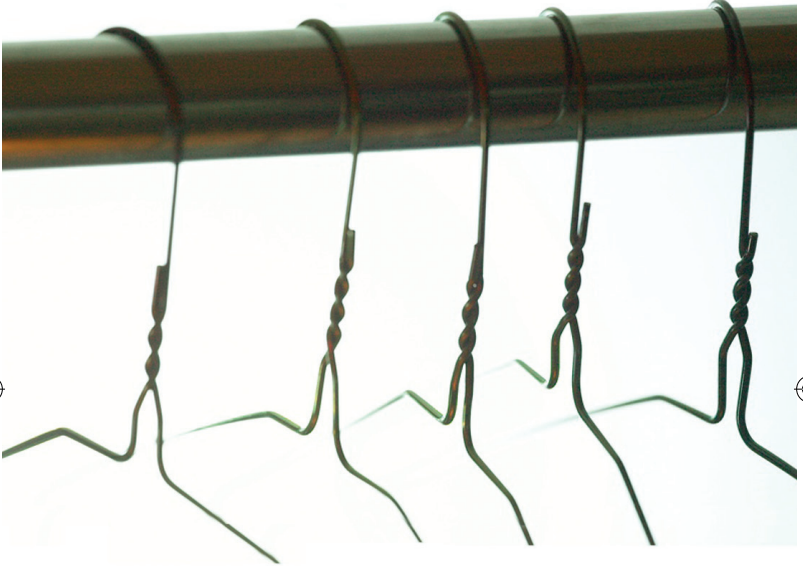

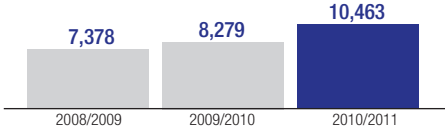

### Number of applications



In the last financial year, State Schools' Relief processed 10,463 applications.

Of those, 84% of Secondary schools and 40% Primary schools utilised SSR's services.

We rely solely on donations to fund the program.

Unlike many charities, no donations are used for administration purposes. The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development covers all administrative costs, ensuring 100% of donations go directly to students in need.
